

CSSS.NET awarded Navy SeaPort-e contract vehicle

The Navy announced the award of the SeaPort Enhanced (SeaPort-e) contract vehicle for a mixture of support services for all phases of weapons systems acquisition contracts nationwide worth a total of \$5.3 billion annually to 503 contractors. CSSS.NET was the only Nebraska based company to be awarded.

The indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity contracts R&D support, prototyping, acquisition logistics, modeling, test & evaluation and engineering support for the Naval Sea Systems Command, Naval Air Systems Command, Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, Naval Supply Systems Command, Military Sealift Command, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Strategic Systems Programs, and the Marine Corps.

SeaPort-e has a 4-year base period with one 5-year award term and one additional 1-year award term. Contract funds will be obligated at the time of task order award and as such, multiple funding types (with varying expiration dates) may be used, consistent with the purpose for which the funds were appropriated. The Naval Sea Systems Command, Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren Division, Dahlgren, VA is the contracting agency.
